Pattison's Academy is a Charleston nonprofit with four hallmark programs serving individuals with developmental delays and disabilities.

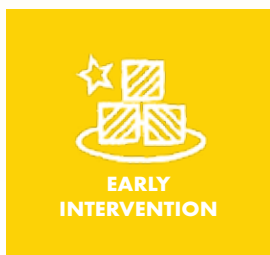
From birth through adulthood, Pattison's interdisciplinary cooperative offers the resources and functional support services that protect every child's right to reach their full potential while also empowering their families.

Our unique model combines three programs into one, so Pattison's has a home for nearly anyone on the disability continuum.

Camp Program

AGES **3-21**

Our flagship program providing an equitable summer experience for all.

Buddy Program

AGES **8-13**

A small group experience to promote independence and build on social skills.

Junior Counselors

AGES **19-24**

Our post-secondary program with a focus on local collaboration, building independence and job skills.

Pattison's foundational program, Therapeutic Summer Camp, has served individuals with disabilities in the tri-county area for 17 years. For **four weeks** through the summer individuals with disabilities are invited to participate in a program that, unlike other camps, **isn't adapted to them - it's made for them.**

WHAT TO EXPECT

Because we aim to provide a custom experience for every participant, there are limited spots available. Don't be discouraged! Mark your calendars for **FEBRUARY 5TH** and head to our social media accounts, or website to secure your child's slot. Following the application window, you will be contacted by a member of our camp team to set up a therapy evaluation to determine your child's placement. Evaluations will take place from **APRIL 1ST-5TH, 2024**.

Curious about tuition? At Pattison's, the wellbeing of your entire family is a priority. We understand the full financial cost of camp is not always feasible but we believe that should never stand in the way of this experience for your child. Summer camp tuition is based on a **case-by-case sliding scale**, so no need to worry.
