

At Pattison's Academy Therapeutic Summer Camp, our aim is to provide an immersive and enjoyable summer experience, like every child deserves, ensuring they grow, connect with friends, and explore new activities. We prioritize creating a worry-free environment for campers and families, assuring that each campers physical, medical, and emotional needs are collaboratively addressed each day.



WHO IS CAMP FOR?

Our unique model combines three programs into one, so Pattison's has a home for nearly anyone on the disability continuum.



Pattison's foundational program, Therapeutic Summer Camp, has served individuals with disabilities in the tri-county area for 17 years. For **four weeks** through the summer individuals with disabilities are invited to participate in a program that, unlike other camps, **isn't adapted to them - it's made (or them.**

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-• PHYSICAL THERAPY

At Summer Camp, *Physical Therapy* is all about **EMPOWERING** kids to **move**, **play**, and **experience** the joy of independence.

With tools like gait trainers and walkers, we make sure every child can join in on the fun, from playing games to playing sports. It's not just therapy; it's about making every moment count. For children with severe disabilities, this becomes a transformative journey, empowering them to navigate their environment more effectively, engage in activities, and experience a sense of independence.

SPEECH THERAPY



Communication is the heart of our Summer Camp, and Speech Therapy is the language of fun. From using cool communication devices to expressing thoughts during outings, **we make sure every child has a voice.** Whether

commenting on the wonders of the aquarium or choosing colors for crafts using picture symbols, Speech Therapy seamlessly integrates into camp activities. It's about *empowering* kids to share their world in their own awesome way.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY O

Occupational Therapy plays a crucial role in our Therapeutic Summer Camp, aiming to refine fine motor skills, sensory processing, and functional abilities. From mastering grasping techniques to engaging in adaptive baseball, Occupational Therapy at camp goes beyond skill development—we're empowering campers to actively participate in the world around them.



Our unique model integrates and incorporates therapy hours, medical services and adaptive activities.

The Alternative.

Lack of year-round programming for children with disabilities brings more than just the typical "summer lull." For individuals that rely heavily on regular Physical, Occupational and Speech therapy a break in the summer months leads to skill regression. Because so much of our community isn't accessible, many of the individuals we serve would be home-bound through the summer. Instead of summer fun, they'd be facing isolation.

From a family perspective, in the absence of trusted and highly trained programs for their child, summer gaps leave caregivers no choice but to stay home with their child-a financial hit many cannot afford and making employability complicated.
